The S&P Latin America 35 ADR SM Index (Bloomberg symbol: BKTLA) is a free float-adjusted capitalization-weighted index. The Index is designed to track the performance of a basket of companies that have their primary equity listing on stock exchanges of Latin American countries and that also have Depositary Receipts that trade on a U.S. exchange or on The Nasdaq Stock Market. The Index currently consists of the following Latin American countries: Argentina, Brazil, Chile, Colombia, Mexico and Peru. It is not possible to invest directly in an index.




